This user-friendly freely available alternative to the Government ORCalc software, offers a number of advantages:

- > Personal user area to store and manage DEC submissions
- > Integrated 'Help' section and the option to purchase technical support credits

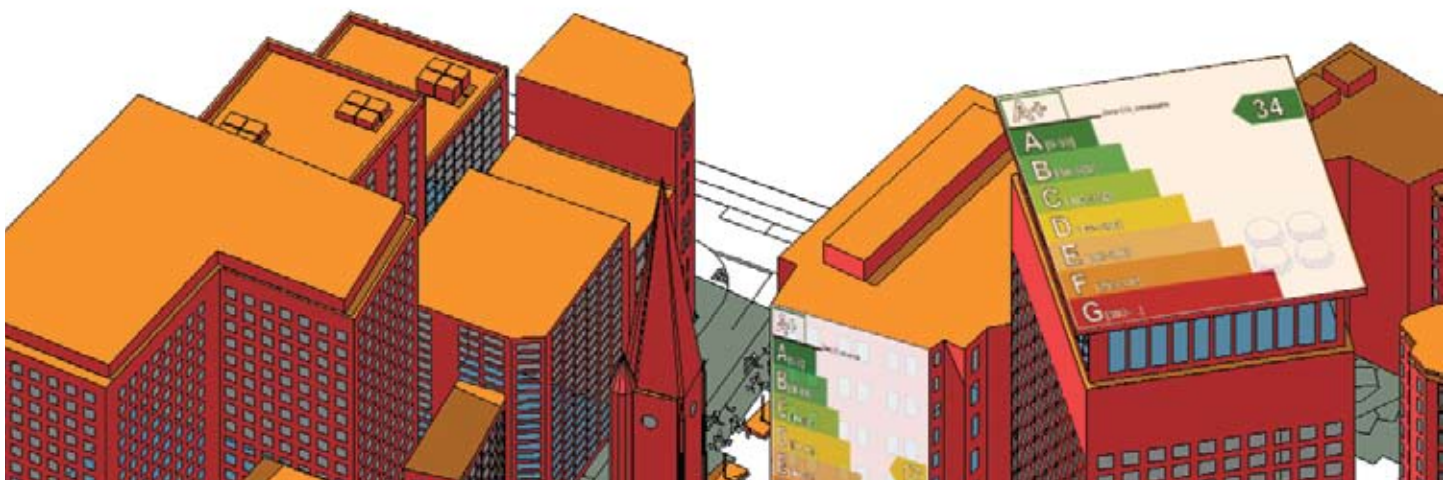
ACCREDITATION, TRAINING & CERTIFICATION

DEC's and Advisory Reports can only be created and lodged by an Accredited DEC Energy Assessor. IES offer a flexible range of e-training and examination sessions (linked with Approved Accreditation Schemes) in the use of the IES <DEC Assessor> software, enabling you to apply and register as a DEC Assessor.

DEC KEY DATES

By October 1st 2008 if you are an **occupier** of a building requiring a DEC, you will need to display a DEC showing an Operational Rating in a prominent place clearly visible to the public.

By October 1st 2008 you will also need to have in your possession or control a valid **Advisory Report**.
